## SHARABLE

**SPRING PEAS & CUCUMBER SALAD** ✓ 18  
*gem lettuce hearts, watermelon radish, celery, mint vinaigrette*

**Siirtolapuutarha Print (city garden)**  
 In the Siirtolapuutarha pattern, designed by Maija Louekari, we follow the journey from the city to the allotment garden overflowing with flowers and vegetables.

**SMOKED FISH TARTINE** 19  
*smoked whitefish, red onion, dill, yogurt, lumpfish caviar, rye*

**Iso Laine Print (big wave)**  
 The plush Iso Laine was first seen in Annika Rimala's iconic dresses in the second half of the 1960s.

**CABBAGE ROLL** 17  
*savoy cabbage, beef, rice, spiced tomato, lingonberry relish*

**Muija Print (colloquial word for 'woman')**  
 Designed by Maija Isola in 1968, the likable and modest Muija sometimes stays out of the spotlight, but never for long.

**SALMON KASU CHOWDER** 18  
*kasu-cured salmon, potato, carrot, leek, dill*

**Pullopusti Print (message in a bottle)**  
 Maija Isola's Pullopusti print was inspired by the island of Crete in the Mediterranean—the designer was enchanted by the endlessly fascinating sea world.

**PACIFIC SHRIMP SKAGEN** 17  
*atlantic northern shrimp, dill & yuzu crème fraîche, preserved lemon, shiso*

**Kesätori Print (summer market)**  
 Aino-Maija Metsola's colourful Kesätori design is bound to make your mouth water.

**FINNA COLADA (1.5 OZ.)** 13  
*finlandia vodka, pineapple juice, coconut milk, lime juice, simple syrup*

**Meduusa Print (jellyfish)**  
 Maija Isola's Meduusa print was originally part of a collection entitled Aurinko ja Meri (The Sun and the Sea), inspired by the beauty of underwater life.

**BERRY CAIPIROSKA (2 OZ.)** 15  
*finlandia vodka, lime juice, simple syrup, blueberries*

**Rukinlapa Print (distaff, spinning tool)**  
 Created by Antti Kekki, the Rukinlapa pattern was inspired by traditional, ornamental handicrafts.
